*“From this time many of his disciples turned back...Peter answered “We believe...”
(Jn 6.60, 66)*

“Among the crowds there was widespread whispering...” (Jn 7.12)

“At this they tried to seize him...still many in the crowd believed in him...” (Jn 7.30-31)

(Jn 7.40-43)*
