<i>Jesus changes water to wine (John 2)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Disciples <u>put their faith</u> in him (John 2.11)</i>
<i>Healing the Official's Son (John 4)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>"The man took Jesus at his word and departed (50)</i> • <i>"...he and all his household believed." (53)</i>
<i>Healing at the Pool (John 5)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>In answering about the healing, Jesus said: "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life..."(24)</i>
<i>Feeding the 5,000 (John 6)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>"I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and who believes in me will never be thirsty." (35)</i> • <i>"For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life" (40)</i> • <i>"He who believes has everlasting life" (47)</i>
<i>Jesus walks on water (John 6)</i>	
<i>Healing of the Blind Man (John 9)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>"Do you believe in the Son of Man?" (35)</i> • <i>"Tell me so that I may believe." (36)</i> • <i>"I believe!" (38)</i>
<i>Raising Lazarus from the dead (John 11)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>"Lazarus is dead and I'm glad I wasn't there so that you may <u>believe</u>." (11.15)</i> • <i>"I am the resurrection and the life. He who <u>believes</u> in me will live...do you <u>believe</u>?" (John 11.25-26)</i> • <i>"I <u>believe</u> that you are the Christ..." (John 11.27)</i> • <i>Jesus prays: "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. I knew that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may <u>believe</u> that you sent me." (John 11.41-42)</i> • <i>"...many of the Jews who had come to visit Mary, and had seen what Jesus did, <u>put their faith</u> in him." (John 11.45) [same greek word]</i> • <i>"the Chief priests made plans to kill Lazarus as well, for on account of him many of the Jews were going over to Jesus and <u>putting their faith</u> in him." (John 12.10-11)</i>
