<b>Suppliants:</b> Came to Jesus asking for something	Simon's mother in law	1.29ff.	Healed
	Man with Leprosy	1.40ff.	Cured and sent away silently
	Paralytic dropped through roof	2.1ff.	Healed
	Man with Shriveled hand	3.1ff.	Healed
	Demon possessed man	5.1ff.	Healed and wanted to go with Jesus but Jesus told him to stay
	Jairus and the dead girl	5.21-24; 5.35-43	Raised his daughter from the dead
	Sick Woman	5.25-34	Healed her through his cloak
	John the Baptist	6.14-29	Wanted answers: got beheaded
	Syrophoenician Woman	7.24-30	Healed her daughter
	Deaf and Mute Man	7.31-37	Healed and told to keep secret
	Blind Man at Bethsaida	10.22-26	Healed and told to keep secret
	Boy with an Evil Spirit	9.14-27	Healed
	Rich Young Man	10.17-22	Answered his question and he left sad
James and John	10.35-45	Rebuked them	
<b>Both</b>	<b>Bartimaeus</b>	<b>10.46-52</b>	<b>Healed and Followed</b>
<b>Exemplars:</b> Examples of what it means to live his teachings!	The Poor Widow	12.41-44	Example of faith/trust
	Woman at Bethany	14.1-11	Was praised for anointing him/told that she will be an example forever
	Simon of Cyrene	15.21	Carried the Cross (8.34)
	The Roman Centurion	15.39	Confessed Jesus Able to recognize the suffering and divinity together (contrast with the disciples)
	The Women at the Cross	15.40-41	Followed to the Cross
	Joseph of Arimathea	15.42-47	Took down Jesus body from the cross (6.29)
	Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome	16.1-7	Jesus appeared to them
<b>Negative examples</b>	The women	16.8	Fled terrified
	The two disciples in the country	16.12	Did not believe
	The Eleven	16.14	Rebuked them for their lack of faith and stubborn refusal to believe
